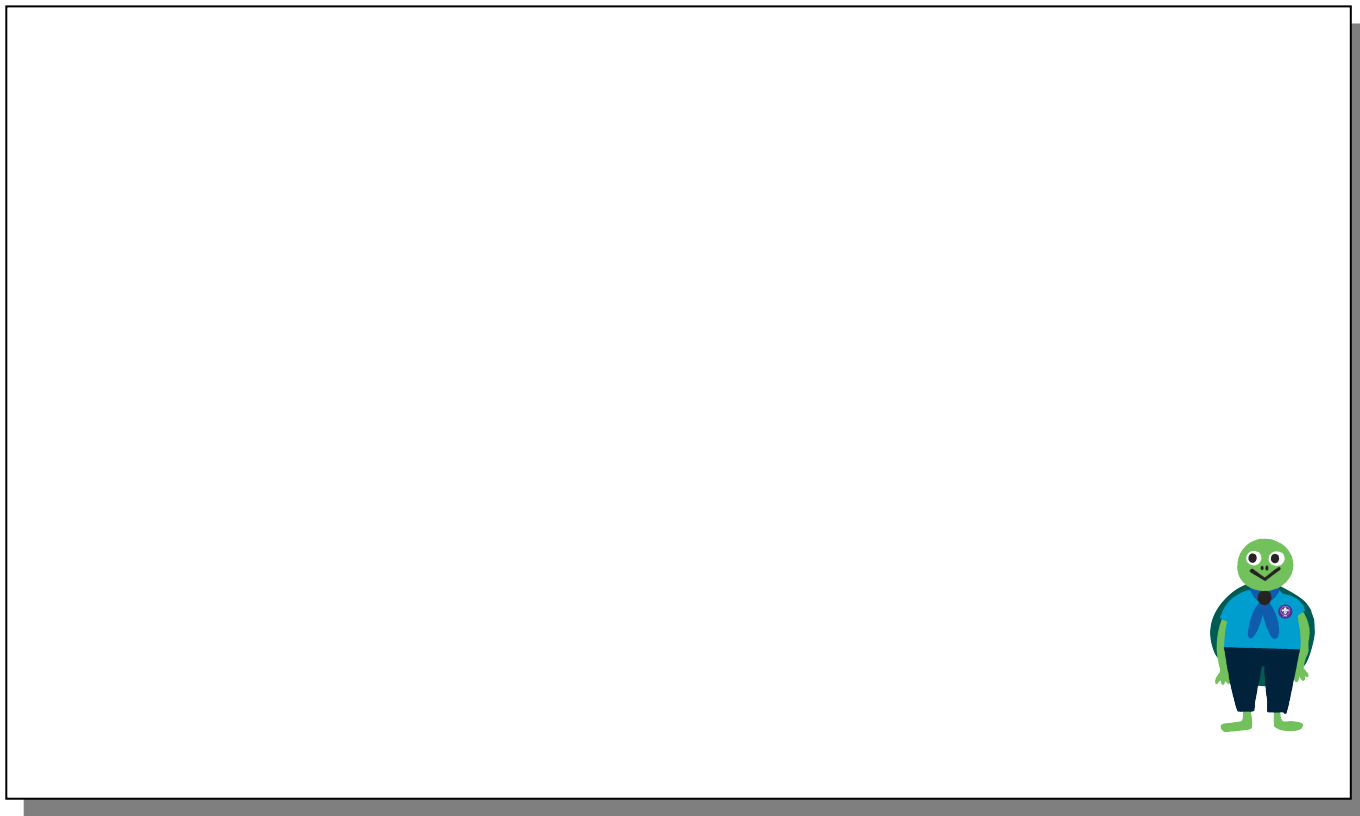
At the end of our Beaver meeting we say a prayer. If you would like to join in you can. If you prefer not to say the prayer that's okay too.
